As a community we are embracing more fully the challenge of analysing collective trauma, intergenerational transmission and the historical context that organises our psychic experience both in clinical, organisational, cultural, and political life of group analysis. These papers ask us to adopt an intersectional way of thinking about the problem of sameness and difference and its relation to power. Our experiences of privilege or marginalisation takes place within specific social historical contexts and the work of this special issue is to support us to keep reflecting on how these positionings affect our practise and can lead to unconscious re-enactments. Group analysis positioned itself as holding in tandem the personal, social, and political as inextricably linked and a key formative process. Therefore, the pattern of projective processes in marginalised groups as a process of disownment requires us to be challenged. Please join us in celebrating this achievement in creating a special issue on racism within group analytic practise as we come together as a community.
